Los Cabos “Hotel with a Heart” Invites Guests to Assist during Upcoming Sea Turtle Release; 14 Olive Ridley Sea Turtle Nests Anticipated to Hatch on Marquis Los Cabos’ Beach Between 9/22 & 10/20

Los Cabos, Mexico (September 22, 2009) – The oceanfront Marquis Los Cabos resort is getting ready for the hatching of its 14 Olive Ridley sea turtle nests, with guests and employees invited to assist in the release. Every year in July, several Olive Ridley – also known as golfina – turtles lay their eggs on the beach in front of the resort. Certified by the state-sponsored PROFEPA agency as a sea turtle watch and rescue site, the resort protects the eggs from laying to hatching. With the first nest expected to hatch today (Sept. 22nd), additional nests are anticipated to hatch September 27 & 30 and October 1 & 8-10 with the remaining six nests between October 15 and 20th. From now through December 19th, rates start at \$235 - a 30% discount - for a Junior Suite for last minute travelers when booking less than two weeks in advance.
